BUNNY



Here is a cute little **BUNNY** pattern that has been a wonderful hit with our little patients. The body has a finished size of about 8" tall, and about 5 1/4" at the widest part of his ears. The optional hat is two circles of flannel sewn together and has a finished size about 4 1/2". Cut an "X" in the middle of the hat and it just slips down over his ears. **BUNNY** is just the right size for little hands. This **BUNNY** pattern was given to us by Jan at Conservatory Senior Living in Keller, TX. **BUNNY** is made with flannel preferably, but other soft fabrics would work just fine, and is stuffed with fiberfill. Anyone who has an embroidery machine and wants the embroidery information can contact Bob at janandbob@sbcglobal.net for instructions. Those without embroidery machines can be creative with appliqué, thread, yarn, or maybe another idea.
