Tote Bag with Straps

**Tote Bags** are given to patients who may be leaving the hospital and going to a foster home. **Tote Bags** may also be used at some of our summer camps.

They are usually the size of an average tote bag (20" by 20") and can be closed by drawstring, by a flap with Velcro, or something similar. They may or may not have carrying straps.

Canvas or other more-rugged type fabrics are desirable, but not a requirement. You can make them on the serger or whatever way that is easiest for you. It is just a basic tote bag.
